

JOB TITLE: Shelter Coordinator REPORTS TO: Executive Director STATUS: Exempt/Full-time

POSITION SUMMARY:

Responsible for the overall management and day-to-day operations of the Men's and/or Women & Children Shelter facilities of the Montana Rescue Mission. There are four major areas of responsibility for this position: 1) Staff and Volunteer management 2) Developing and maintaining an atmosphere that encourages and supports spiritual growth and development 3) Direct guest interaction to support MRM programs and activities, and 4) Working with the Maintenance Staff to insure that the facilities are safe and sound so that programs, services and activities of the Shelter can be accomplished.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

- Recruit, train, oversee and evaluate direct reports. Handle scheduling, approve over-time, maintain attendance records and oversees time-off requests, discipline and provide correction as warranted.
- Work with the appropriate Support Services Staff to maintain the Shelter buildings and grounds in a clean, safe, efficient and cost-effective manner and recommend major repairs to buildings to Maintenance Supervisor.
- Work with MRM guests and Program Participants as part of work therapy assignments. Provide encouragement, instruction, and feedback.
- Work collaboratively with HR and Programs Director to ensure that job descriptions for staff are accurate and up to date.
- In collaboration with the Program Director assist in the on-going development of the Guest Services Policy & Procedure Manual and enforce all MRM Guest policy and guidelines.
- Shall be the first-on-call for shelter emergencies pertaining to needs of the MRM guests or security issues. Will then notify management staff as needed.
- Collaborate with Program Director on the delivery and facilitation of all programming. Assist in the
 development, implementation, and administration of all long-term MRM programs including chapel services,
 Bible studies and special events for guests.
- Cooperate with outside agencies referring guests for outside care and basic social service providers.
- Oversee gathering and reporting of statistical information as requested by MRM Office including the required online data program.
- Serve on-call, on weekends, evenings, on a rotating / as needed basis.
- Occasionally be willing to speak to outside groups.
- Attend and/or conduct weekly staff meetings.
- Attend outside training as required for job and as directed by supervisor.
- Other duties as assigned
- Track guest outcomes
- Make sure GSO staff are tracking CACFP and SNAP cards. Make sure this is done correctly and kept up to date
- Train GSO to teach needed classes and arrange for GSO staff to transport guests to classes as needed.

SKILLS/QUALIFICATIONS:

• Mature Christian who has a heart to work in a ministry environment that reaches out to the poor, homeless, addicted, and mentally ill.



- Able and willing to model Christ-likeness in word and deed
- Ability to relate to and consult creatively and effectively with staff, guests, co-workers and superiors.
- Evidence of creativity, innovation and vision.
- Working knowledge of the Bible and discipleship strategies.
- Knowledge of physical plant operations and procedures
- Good knowledge of Microsoft Office products, database management and Internet utilization
- Able to develop and refine procedures to fulfill policy and goals of MRM.
- Ability to provide leadership and inspire the confidence of others.
- Evidence of sound decision making abilities.
- Ability to communicate ideas and concepts effectively and respectfully
- A commitment to Biblical peacemaking
- Excellent attitude, personable, friendly and courteous
- Valid Montana Driver's License; ability to be insured by MRM vehicle insurer

Work will involve interactions with a diverse guest population and may continuously involve working with people who struggle with mental illness, addiction, may be under the influence of alcohol, and/or have poor personal hygiene. - Frequently

- Lift and/or move up to 4 0 pounds. Occasionally
